# Hardy Recipes for January

## CRACK CHICKEN NOODLE SOUP

- 3 cups chopped, cooked chicken
- 1 (10.75-oz.) can cheese soup
- 6 cups chicken broth
- 1 cup milk
- 2 stalks celery, chopped
- 2 carrots, thinly sliced
- 1 (1-oz.) pkg. Hidden Valley Ranch Salad Dressing & Seasoning Mix
- 1 (2.25-oz.) pkg. real bacon bits
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 8-oz. pkg. dried fine egg noodles, uncooked



In a large stockpot/Dutch oven, combine chicken, cheese soup, chicken broth, milk, celery, carrots, Ranch mix, and bacon bits. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat. Reduce heat to simmer and cook for 20 to 25 minutes, until vegetables are soft. Stir in dried noodles and cheddar cheese. Cook for 5 minutes, until noodles are soft.

## COWBOY CASSEROLE

- 1/2 pound lean ground beef (90% lean)
- 1 can 8-3/4 oz.) whole kernel corn, drained

- 2/3 cup cream of chicken soup,
- 1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese, divided
- 1/3 cup 2% milk
- 2 Tbsp. sour cream
- 3/4 tsp onion powder
- 1/4 tsp. pepper
- 2 cups frozen Tater Tots

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. In a large skillet, cook beef over medium heat until no longer pink. Stir in the corn, soup, 1/4 cup cheese, milk, sour cream, onion powder and pepper. Place 1 cup Tater Tots in a greased 3-cup baking dish. Layer with beef mixture and remaining Tater Tots; sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake uncovered, 20-25 minutes, or until bubbly. Yields 2 servings.



## CORN CASSEROLE

- 1 can cream style corn
- 1 box Jiffy corn bread mix

- 2 eggs
- 1 stick melted butter
